

17 Hulme Court Myaree Electric Vehicle Charging

Welcome to the 17 Hulme Court, Myaree, Electric Vehicle Charging Stations. Here you will find the information you require for charging your EV.

1. Who can use these charging stations & when can I use them?

Unit 3 (1 outlet): Members of the public: All times.

If you are an Entire Tech customer and have come in to transact with us during business hours, please let our team know beforehand so we can provide you with complimentary charging of your EV for up to 2 hours.

If you are not an Entire Tech customer and would like to charge your EV, please scan the Charge Hub QR code and follow the instructions.

Unit 5 (2 outlets): Members of the public: Monday to Friday – From 6.00pm to 6.00am. Saturday and Sunday – all times.

These outlets are reserved for the Entire Tech fleet vehicles during the hours of 6.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday. Drivers, please be mindful of Entire Tech reserved parking signs there for their fleet.

2. How do I start charging my EV?

These charging stations utilise the Charge Hub system to manage your charging. Locate the QR code on the side panel of the charging station, scan the code with your mobile phone camera and follow the instructions.

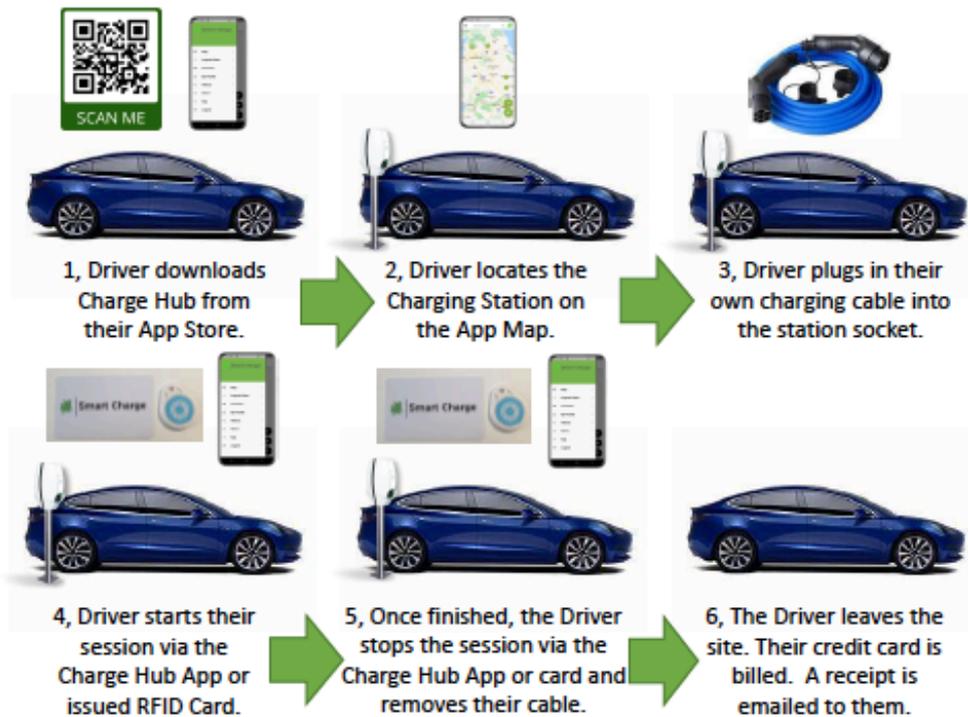

3. How many charging stations are there at 17 Hulme Court?

There are 3 stations located at 17 Hulme Court – 1 outlet at Unit 3 and 2 outlets at Unit 5.

4. Can I only charge a certain brand of EV?

All makes of EVs can be charged here.

5. Do I need my own charging cable?

Yes, you need your own charging cable.

6. How long can I use these chargers for?

Vehicles can be connected to any station for a **maximum of 2 hours**. After the 2-hour time limit, please exit the charging bay within 15 minutes as additional fees will apply after this period. It is the driver's responsibility to observe the time limit and not rely on Charge Hub notifications.

7. What rate will I be charged for charging my EV?

Unit 3:

- Fee: \$0.45 per kWh (for a maximum of 2 hours). If you are transacting with us during business hours, please let our team know beforehand so we can provide you with complimentary charging for up to 2 hours.
- After the 2-hour limit, you will have a 15-minute grace period to exit the charging bay.

Unit 5:

- Fee: \$0.45 per kWh (for a maximum of 2 hours).
- After the 2-hour limit, you will have a 15-minute grace period to exit the charging bay.
- After the 15-minute grace period, the fee will changeover to the idle fee of \$1.00/minute. It is the driver's responsibility to observe the time limit and not rely on Charge Hub notifications.

8. What if there are any issues with the charging stations?

Call Charge Hub on 1300 986 767 if you have any issues with your account or with using the station.

9. Who owns the charging stations?
